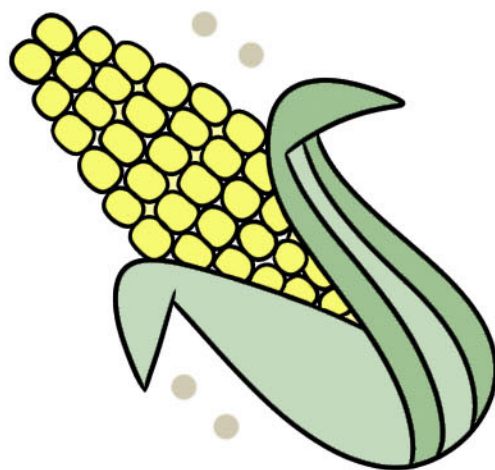
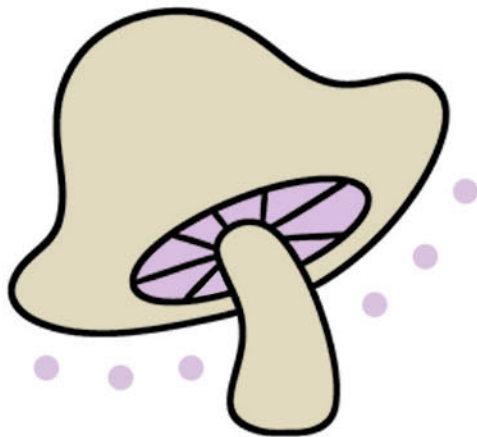
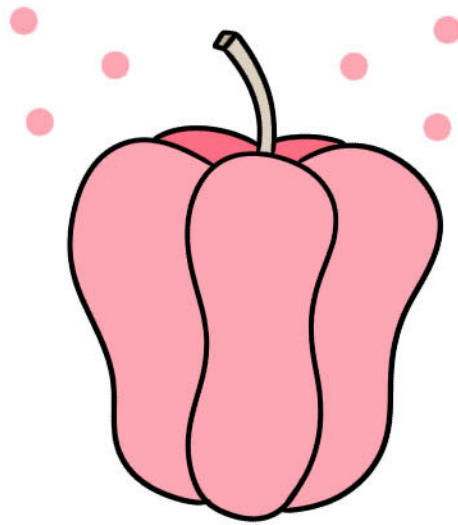
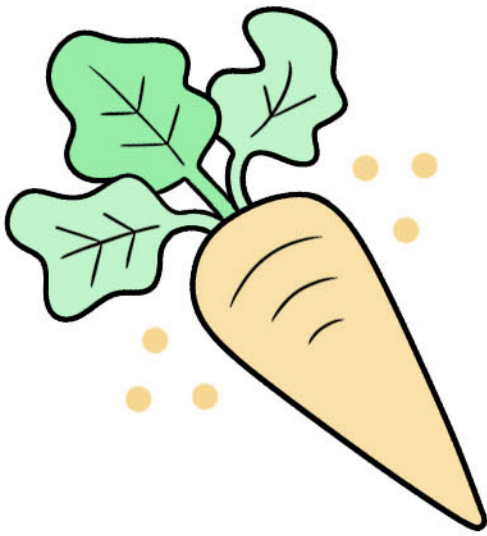
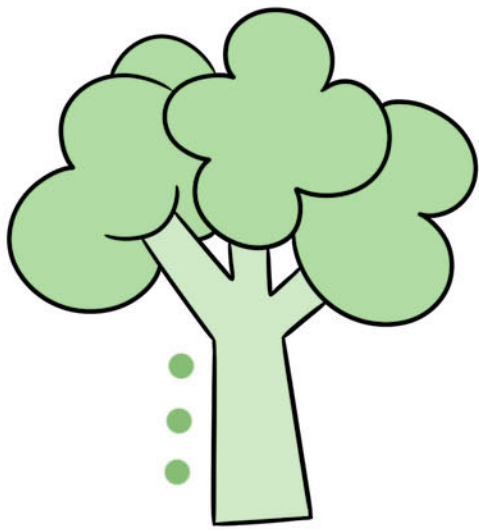


# Fruit Matching Game
